Official Information Request

Thank you for your letter of 18 May 2010, requesting copies of any correspondence or documentation held by the Department of Internal Affairs regarding NORML News magazine.

Please find attached the following:

- Notes of a meeting held on 31 March 2010, between departmental officers and two police officers, during which the existence of several publications dealing with the cultivation of cannabis and other illegal activity was discussed. The names of the attending police officers have been withheld in terms of section 6(c) of the Official Information Act (where the making available of the information would be likely to prejudice the maintenance of the law). Other information has been deleted as not being within the scope of your request.
- A police property record sheet for the six publications provided by the New Zealand Police to the Censorship Compliance Unit of the Department of Internal Affairs. The names of the submitting police officers have been withheld in terms of section 6(c) of the Official Information Act (where the making available of the information would be likely to prejudice the maintenance of the law).
- A letter to the Chief Censor, dated 3 May 2010, submitting three editions of NORML News magazine for classification and the completed Notice of Submission form.
- A letter to the General Manager of NORML NZ Inc, notifying that three editions of NORML News magazine had been submitted to the Office of Film and Literature Classification for classification.
